## CITIZENS OF THIRD COUNTRIES ARE INVITED TO JOIN INTERESTING INTEGRATION COURSES

Integration courses and other activities are implemented in the project **“We - in Latvia 2”** (Grant Agreement No. PMIF /8/2019/3/03). Project aim is to provide integration courses for target group – **300 citizens of third countries\*** (Russia, Ukraine, Belarus, Uzbekistan, China, India, Kazakhstan and others) that are legally staying on Latvian territory.

During integration courses, that consist of **24 academic hours**, there will be a possibility to learn about interesting topics that are necessary for living in Latvia:

- Public administration and law;
- History, traditions and culture of Latvia;
- Social services, education and health care;
- Society, everyday life and free time (active rest, sports and social events, beautiful places in Latvia), civic participation
- Latvian language at work and at home;
- Opportunities for starting a business (practical examples in calculating taxes, preparing a business plan, business incubators, social entrepreneurship).

Course supervisors are experienced and competent workers of The State Revenue Service, as well as other professionals working in public administration structures and fields.

Courses are provided in several languages.
